On March 19 - March 20, 2025, the INTA New York Conference, which features *“Business of Trade Secrets: Navigating the Challenges and Opportunities in the Ever-Changing World of AI”*, is convened in New York city.

The two-day Conference explores the role of trade secrets in maintaining a competitive advantage, dissects the relationship between trade secrets and other forms of intellectual property, including when to opt for trade secret protection, and how effectively to enforce trade secrets globally in the ever-changing AI landscape.

Civil Trade Secret Case

Prove trade secret and infringement – by
• P: Likelihood of infringement, protective
access, and similarity
• D: Public knowledge and legitimate use

Prove damages – adverse inference
• Compensatory: preliminary evidence
• Punitive: 1-5 times of compensatory

Injunction: compulsory enforcement
